## **Copperstate Fly-in announces move to Falcon Field Airport**

Copperstate Fly-In, Inc., which hosts the fourth-largest aircraft fly-in in the U.S., has announced that it will hold its next event to Falcon Field Airport on Friday & Saturday, October 28-29, 2016.

The event, which is open to the general public, attracts recreational & general aviation enthusiasts from across the southwest United States. In 2015, approximately 500 aircraft were on display from 20 states, including ultralights, gyrocopters, home-built aircraft, antiques and warbirds. In addition to aircraft displays, the Copperstate Fly-In features aircraft awards, aviation business information booths, educational workshops for pilots, and youth activities. A portion of event proceeds fund scholarships for youth aviation programs.

“We’re happy to make the move to Falcon Field and feel it will afford us greater opportunity for expansion,” Stephen Bass, Copperstate President and Fly-In Manager, said.
