

Dear Falcon Field Airport Tenants and Aeronautical Users,

As we previously shared with you, on March 23, 2026, the Mesa City Council unanimously approved the implementation of landing fees at Falcon Field Airport, as well as other fees and charges adjustments. The City recognizes that many of you have questions about the upcoming landing fee program and its implementation. We appreciate your patience as this process moves forward.

The City Department of Innovation & Technology is leading the procurement process for the landing fee collection services. This department developed a Request for Proposals (RFP) and provided it to SHI, Inc., which has a contract with the City to assist in identifying and procuring information technology solutions. Leveraging the existing contract with SHI, Inc. represents the most efficient procurement path and allows the City to move forward quickly. City staff is currently conducting its due diligence review of an RFP response received from SHI, Inc. The selection committee will be making a recommendation on a vendor selection to the Department of Innovation & Technology by the middle of April 2026.

Once a vendor has been hired, more information will be available to answer your questions related to billing procedures, payment options, and program administration. Specific billing questions will be addressed at that time.
