

Notice Regarding Implementation of Landing Fees at Falcon Field Airport

Dear Falcon Field Airport Tenants and Aeronautical Users,

As a follow-up to our previous communication, we would like to provide an update regarding the implementation of landing fees at Falcon Field Airport.

As you are aware, the Mesa City Council approved the new and modified fees and charges, including landing fees, for Falcon Field Airport with an effective date of May 1, 2026. The City departments of Innovation and Technology, Business Services, and the Airport are currently finalizing a contract with the selected third-party vendor to provide landing fee collection services.

As outlined in Resolution No. 12480, which was approved by City Council on March 23, 2026, the Airport Director may delay the implementation of landing fees to a date when the third-party flight tracking system is in place, not to exceed 90 days from May 1st. In order to allow the vendor time to accomplish this, the implementation of landing fees is being postponed and **will not occur on May 1, 2026**. The implementation date will depend on how quickly the contract can be signed with the vendor and the system put in place to begin charging the fees. The current projected implementation date is no later than July 30, 2026; however, if this date occurs sooner, we will notify aeronautical users in advance on the Falcon Field Airport website. In addition, as more information becomes available regarding billing procedures, payment options, and program administration, we will let you know.

All other fees and charges adjustments for Falcon Field Airport that were approved by City Council will become effective on May 1, 2026.

We understand that the landing fee program has generated questions within the airport community, and we appreciate your continued patience as we work to ensure a smooth and effective implementation.
